Mike Sievers is a partner in the Albuquerque law firm McGinn Montoya Love Curry & Sievers, PA, where he has been an attorney since graduating from the University of New Mexico School of Law and passing the bar in 2013. He was born and raised in Gallup, New Mexico, graduated from New Mexico State University with a bachelor's in journalism and mass communications, and worked as a sportswriter and editor in Silver City, New Mexico, Socorro, New Mexico, and Cortez, Colorado before starting law school.

Mike specializes in representing people who have been catastrophically injured, and the families of those who have been killed, in crashes involving commercial motor vehicles. He is an advocate for commercial motor vehicle safety and roadway safety. In March of this year, Mike and his law partner Elicia Montoya obtained a \$25.56 million verdict in a case against the New Mexico Department of Transportation for its neglect of a rural intersection, which the jury found was a cause of a crash involving a semi-truck driver who ran a stop sign, causing the plaintiff to suffer a severe brain injury and many other debilitating injuries.

Mike is board certified in truck accident law by the National Board of Trial Advocacy and serves on the board of regents of the ATAA and as a member of the ATAA's Safety Committee. Mike also serves on the board of directors of the New Mexico Trial Lawyers Association and as part of the leadership of the American Association for Justice's Trucking Litigation Group.

Mike has extensively researched the state of the law on driverless vehicles and current issues with the development of driverless vehicles. In 2024, he and ATAA Chair Andy Young testified in front of the Transportation Infrastructure Revenue Subcommittee of the New Mexico Legislature in support of a bill that would require state oversight and safety measures for driverless vehicles, particularly driverless commercial motor vehicles.

In his spare time, Mike enjoys assisting his wife in shuttling two amazing children around to various sporting events and other activities; running long distances; and playing hockey.
